

CONSERVE NOW, CRUISE LATER CONTEST

Join the effort to conserve energy with Atlantic Marine Corps Communities in 2017. Simply, conserve your energy each month and you could be entered into a drawing for a grand prize for an All-Inclusive luxury cruise for two!

Contest period February 1, 2017 through May 31, 2017.

Resident must be participating in the RECP program and be living with Atlantic Marine Corps Communities (AMCC) for at least thirty days prior to each contest period; contest periods run monthly between February and May 2017.

Utility Billing provider will review property usage over the stated contest period from February 1, 2017 through May 31, 2017. At the end of each month, when the RECP utilities usage is measured, each household that meets one of the following criteria will receive one (1) entry into a drawing for a chance to win the grand prize.

Ways to Gain an Entry into the Contest:

1. The RECP participating household has the lowest average electrical use for the month in their like-type group
2. The household lowers their electrical usage over ten percent from the prior month
3. Households share a picture of a utility savings initiative via the AMCC Facebook page utilizing specific hashtag may receive up to one additional entry per month

Drawing will be held after May 31, 2017.

Official Contest Rules:

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. All contestants must be a permanent resident with Atlantic Marine Corps Communities and be living with Atlantic Marine Corps Communities for at least thirty days prior to the contest period. There will be four (4) contest periods where residents will be eligible to receive an entry into the Grand Prize drawing; the first contest period runs from February 1, 2017 to February 28, 2017, the second contest period runs from March 1, 2017 to March 31, 2017, and the third contest period runs from April 1, 2017 to April 30, 2017, and the fourth contest period runs from May 1, 2017 to May 31, 2017. Participants must be living in their home for the entire month that utility usage is measured. If residents leave the home unoccupied for any period of time during the contest period, they will not be eligible to participate for that month's contest.

There will be three (3) grand prizes awarded for the *Conserve Now, Cruise Later* contest. Atlantic Marine Corps Communities will host three (3) separate contests for the following locations:

For **Facebook Energy Savings submissions**, all submissions must be posted to the official Atlantic Marine Corps Communities Facebook page for the identified installation they reside at with the hashtag, **#AMCCenergysavings**. All submissions must be received by the Atlantic Marine Corps Communities Facebook page administrator during the contest periods, as mentioned above to be entered in the monthly contest. One entry, per month, per resident is permitted. Posts must include at least one picture of the resident conserving energy in the home with a description of the picture. Submissions will be reviewed by the Facebook page administrator for relevance to the contest and submitted for entry upon approval. **Contest participants should not rely on Facebook Energy Savings submissions in order to participate.** Atlantic Marine Corps Communities assumes no responsibility for contestants not making timely submissions, or accurate submissions, including incorrect usage of the hashtag or incorrect posting to the Facebook page.
