

PERMISSION TO INSTALL A FENCE

Residents can ONLY erect a fence in the BACKYARD of the property listed below, and the fence CANNOT BE ATTACHED to the RESIDENCE or the ENCLOSED SCREEN PORCH.

Resident agrees that the fence will not exceed 60" in height and will include a gate 36" in width constructed of the same material as the fence. Materials for the fence will be as follows (NO EXCEPTIONS):

- Use chain-link constructed fencing of 11 gauge galvanized chain-link fabric and an end post of 2" galvanized piping
- Line posts will be 1 5/8" galvanized pipe set apart at a maximum of 8' center-to-center
- Posts will be set 12" into the ground
- The top rail will be 1 3/8" galvanized pipe
- Tie wires will be attached every 12"

Resident agree to keep the grass trimmed under and around the fence, to keep the fence in perfect repair and to remove it and fill in the post holes upon my departure from the quarters.

Resident understands that they are fully responsible for restoring the yard to the original condition upon vacating the premises.

Resident understands that they may be asked to move or relocate the fence for current or future construction contracts at no cost to the government or Atlantic Marine Corps Communities (AMCC) at TriCommand.

Approval to install a fence will be considered after the resident has contacted an SCE&G representative for a date, time and ticket number to have gas and electric lines marked. Seventy-two hours before starting the proposed work the resident must contact SCE&G by calling the Palmetto Utility Protection Service at 1-888-721-7877 (888-SC1-PUPS) Monday-Friday, 7:00am to 7:00pm (Eastern Standard Time) or by going to their web page located at www.sc1pups.org/.

The resident must contact the AMCC Maintenance Department at (877) 509-2424 and request a Work Order to have the geothermal lines marked prior to installing the fence. A picture, or illustration of the location of the proposed fence in relation to the house and the yard, must be returned to an AMCC Resident Service Coordinator with this form.

Resident must MAINTAIN A MINIMUM of 2 FEET of space on each side of the marks. **Resident will be responsible for damage if they dig without having lines marked.**
