SATELLITE DISH INSTALLATION GUIDELINES AS DETAILED FOR VENDOR INSTALL

The preferred option for installation is to mount the dish using the Under Eave Mount (UEM). This should be attached to the back or side of the house whichever will allow reception of signals. At "no time" will the mount be attached to the front of the house or a fence. Alternative installation options may be available, but must be approved in writing by the Community Manager.

Residents, vendors, installers, company representatives and/or related subcontractors are responsible for complying with the following standards for satellite dish installation:

- Do not mount a satellite dish to the following: roofs, eaves, or fencing or attach related hardware to exterior siding and brick (except for the mounting of the Under Eave Mount). Holes will not be made in the siding or brick at any time.
- Satellite system must be installed in a manner that is not unsightly and does not damage the home.
- Tree limbs will not be cut in efforts to obtain a better signal.
- Vendor/installer digging permit from Fort Hood Family Housing Maintenance is not required with the use of the UEM.
- Vendor/installer will use existing cable wiring from the junction box to the outlets within the residence and will not change the location of the box. The vendor/installer may not cut, splice or otherwise damage any existing cable connected to the junction box. If pre-existing cables are connected in the junction box, the vendor/installer must disconnect the wiring, but allow the cable to remain within the box. When installation of a second parallel cable is required, obtain Community Manager's written approval. Installations must be cosmetically acceptable, and the existing entrance hole on home will be used. No additional holes will be made in the interior or exterior surfaces of the home.
- The resident is responsible for removing the system, except for the UEM, and restoring grounds upon move-out.
- System Owner and the Resident remain financially responsible for the damages inflicted to homes and grounds as a result of satellite dish installation or removal. It is also the resident's responsibility to ensure that any private companies they enter into an agreement with to install the satellite dish must comply with these standards.



By signing below you are agreeing to the above guidelines outlined for approved satellite dish installation for Fort Hood Family Housing. By doing so, you will be listed as an approved vendor for satellite dish installation in our communities. If any evidence is found to conclude you have violated any of the installation guidelines, you *will* be immediately removed from the list and not allowed to install satellite dishes for residents residing in Fort Hood Family Housing.
