The table above is a schedule of trash collection days per neighborhood. Trash will be picked up weekly and recycling will be picked up biweekly. Trash and recycle are subject to change. Bulk items can be placed out for pick-up with regular trash on your scheduled trash day. Items that will not be picked up include: Motor oil, wet paint of any kind, large batteries, flammable liquids, freezers or refrigerators that still contain Freon, dirt, rocks, concrete and lawn mowers. Large items such as trampolines must be broken down. Tree branches must be 48 inches or less in length and tied in a bundle weighing less than 40 pounds.





Please be sure to have trash cans out to the curb early on trash day or the night before. Cans must be pulled back to the home on the same day trash is collected.

# Recycling Instructions

Based on the Fort Campbell mandated recycling program, CAM Reg 200-3\*, recycling is now a requirement across the installation, including Campbell Crossing. Please see below for a list of acceptable materials to place in your Waste Industries recycling bin:

<b>METALS</b> 	Tin Food Cans, Aluminum, Beverage Cans	Empty and rinse cans to remove all food residue.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cans used for chemicals or paint</li> <li>Aerosol spray cans</li> <li>Appliances, power tools or batteries</li> </ul>
<b>PLASTICS</b> 	#1-7 Plastic Bottles used for Milk, Juice, Soap and Soft Drinks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rinse containers to remove residue.</li> <li>Discard caps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Containers used for chemicals or automotive products (oil, antifreeze, etc.)</li> <li>Rubber products</li> <li>Styrofoam cups and packing material</li> <li>Photographic film</li> <li>Plastic bags</li> <li>Polyvinyl sheeting</li> <li>Heat shrinking wrapping</li> </ul>
