

Water Meter Installation Project

Hickam Communities' water meter installation project will continue over the next several months. As part of the project, Hickam's water meter subcontractor will need clear access to the grass strips alongside the curb at select homes. For safety reasons, residents will not be able to park in affected areas while work is being conducted. The installation phase in Earhart village and Onizuka Village has been completed and the areas of working being seeded with new grass. As part of the scope of this project, Hickam Communities will be installing meters throughout the Officer Field and Hale Na Koa community through the end of 2018.

A "NO PARKING" reminder sign will be placed at the curb 2 weeks prior to notify residents of the upcoming temporary parking restrictions. We anticipate the actual NO PARKING restriction to be in effect for approximately 1 week in the designated work area. The subcontractor team can be identified by their high visibility shirts and vests, and they will be working week days between the hours of 7:30am and 3:30pm. Additionally, we anticipate water service to be out for approximately 4 hours, between the hours of 9am and 1pm, after meters are installed to complete the connections. Affected residents will be notified prior to the outage. Should your home be affected by an outage, it is important to remember that after your water is turned back on, please let your faucets run for a few minutes to clear any sediment that may have become dislodged from the piping during this work.

The new meters are necessary for Hickam Communities to obtain more accurate consumption data of the entire community and not for individual home billing. Residents will not be charged for water usage. However, water conservation is always encouraged.
