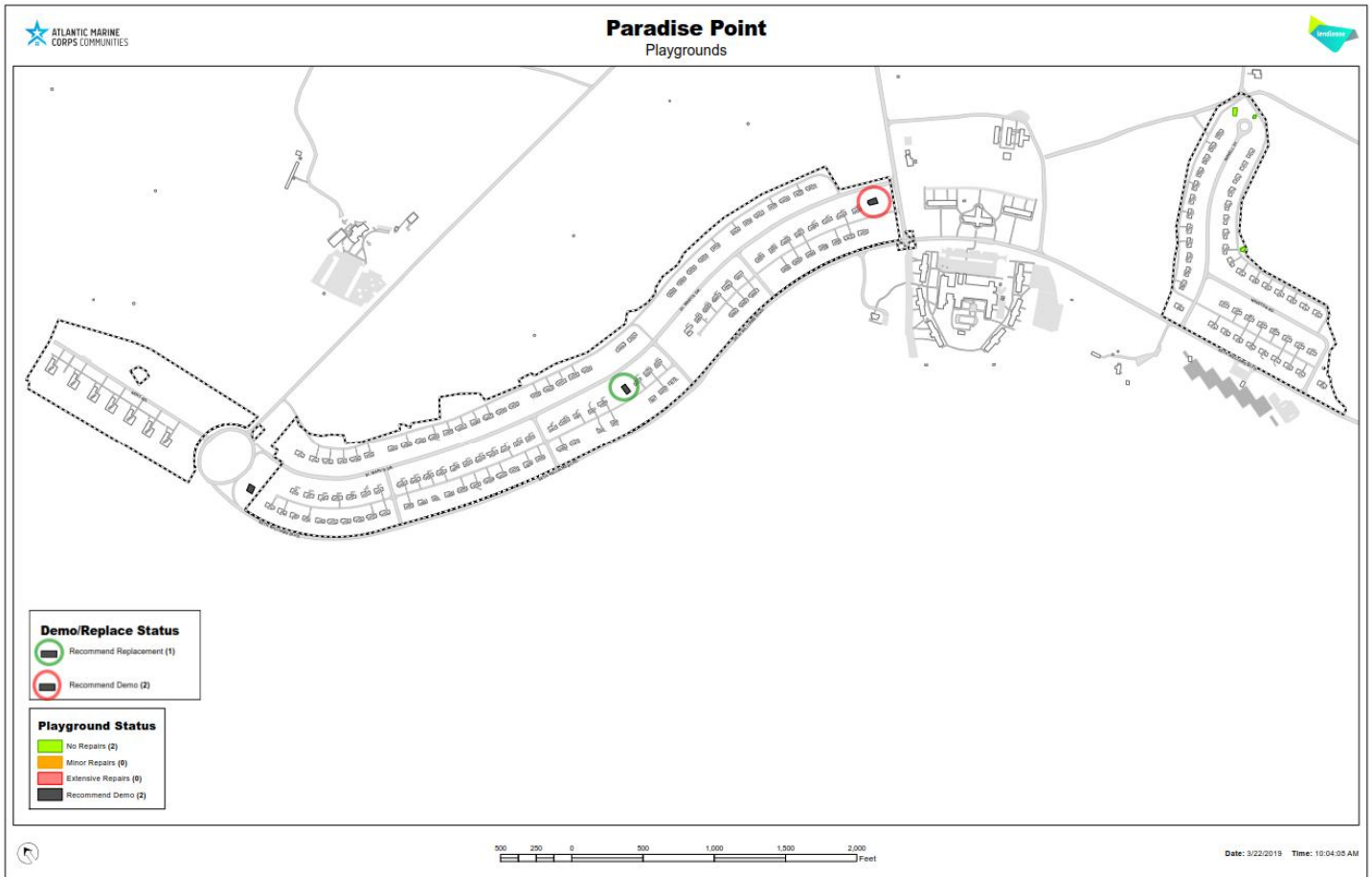




**PLAYGROUND UPDATE  
PARADISE POINT I**



**DEMOLITION CRITERIA**

- Proprietary parts are not interchangeable; only manufacturers parts can be used, which may be obsolete
- Lifecycle of Equipment has expired (aged plastic, aged metal, wear/tear)
- Age of structure and availability of repair parts determines reinvestment
- Multiple manufacturers over several years

**REPLACEMENT & REPAIR FUNDING REQUIREMENTS**

- Demo and Replace = \$1.139m
- Repairs= \$100k
- Evaluating all available funding to meet this requirement, but funding will not equal the requirement.
- We must prioritize which playgrounds we replace, we can't replace them all.
- We need your feedback...tell your community manager

**REPLACEMENT PRIORITIES**

- Overall playground availability in neighborhood
- Walking proximity to other neighborhood playgrounds and other amenities (pavilions, dog parks, etc.)
- Observed regular use of playground
- Funding Capability

**ADDITIONAL SCHOOL PLAYGROUND ACCESS**

- Johnson Primary, Heroes Manor, Tarawa Terrace, and Delalio Elementary School Playgrounds are open to the Base patrons after school hours and on weekends
- All the principals requested that families not bring pets on the playground to avoid having children encounter pet waste and wanted to remind families that the base order regarding ages of unsupervised children should be followed.
